Who We Are

Our identity is not defined by a building, denomination, geographic location, or collection of programs. It is rooted in the biblical calling entrusted to every follower of Jesus Christ: we are ambassadors for Christ.

This calling is not reserved for pastors, missionaries, or church leaders. It belongs to every believer who has placed faith in Jesus Christ. We seek to represent Him faithfully in our homes, workplaces, neighborhoods, communities, and wherever God leads us.

Identity Before Activity

We do not begin by asking what title a person holds. We begin with belonging to Jesus Christ. Salvation is the spiritual qualification for belonging to this Christ-centered community. Growth, service, leadership, property access, and specialized programs may involve separate preparation or administrative safeguards, but they do not determine spiritual acceptance.

Our Shared Purpose

- Know Jesus Christ more deeply.
- Grow in biblical understanding and spiritual maturity.
- Worship, pray, and participate in Christian fellowship.
- Serve others with compassion and faithfulness.
- Represent Jesus Christ in everyday life.

How Ambassadors Grow

Information alone does not produce mature disciples. Spiritual growth is strengthened through faithful teaching, consistent prayer, authentic Christian fellowship, meaningful worship, personal accountability, compassionate service, and applying God's Word to everyday life.

A Healthy Rhythm of Christian Living

- Meet with God daily through Scripture and prayer.
- Learn regularly through biblical teaching.
- Worship consistently.
- Participate in Christian fellowship.
- Serve faithfully.
- Continue developing your gifts.
- Encourage others.
- Remain connected to the Christian community.

The House-to-House Community

The Ambassadors community is not defined by geography, a building, or weekly attendance. It is a community of believers united by faith in Jesus Christ and a desire to represent Him faithfully in everyday life.

A believer's home - wherever it is located - may become a place of prayer, Scripture, worship, encouragement, fellowship, and compassionate care. These household gatherings complement the larger ministry community; they do not compete with it or replace the corporate Body of Christ.

Technology can connect believers across distance, but it should strengthen genuine relationships rather than replace them.

A Simple Household Gathering Plan

A gathering may be small. Begin with the people God has placed in your household or circle of relationship. Keep Jesus Christ, Scripture, prayer, and mutual encouragement at the center.

Suggested 60-Minute Rhythm

- 10 minutes - Welcome, personal check-in, and gratitude.
- 10 minutes - Worship or quiet reflection on God.
- 20 minutes - Read and discuss a Bible passage or Redemptive Life study guide.
- 10 minutes - Share prayer needs and pray for one another.
- 10 minutes - Choose one practical action of obedience, encouragement, or service.

Keep It Open and Christ-Centered

The gathering is an invitation, not a competition or spiritual approval process. Do not pressure people to perform, disclose private matters, give money, or assume a title. Welcome questions. Protect confidentiality. Direct attention to Jesus Christ and the truth of Scripture.

A Simple Invitation

“We are gathering to read Scripture, pray, encourage one another, and grow in Christ. You are welcome to join us. There is no application for spiritual acceptance and no pressure to perform.”

Connection and Responsible Care

You may introduce yourself to Redemptive Life Global Ministries, connect your household, receive updates, and ask for resources or prayer. A connection form is for communication and support - not approval of salvation or spiritual worth.

Administrative Distinctions

Account verification may be used later to protect private information or secure online resources. Separate screening may apply to volunteering, ministry leadership, residence, physical-property access, work with vulnerable people, or specialized programs. These safeguards are administrative and pastoral responsibilities; they are not judgments about whether someone belongs to Christ.

When a Gathering Needs Help

- Seek ministry guidance when serious conflict, safety concerns, abuse, threats, or emergencies arise.
- Do not attempt to provide professional medical, legal, financial, or mental-health treatment without proper qualification.
- Call emergency services when immediate safety is at risk.
- Protect children, vulnerable adults, and confidential personal information.
- Contact ministry leadership when you need teaching materials, prayer support, or help strengthening the gathering.

A Community That Multiplies

As Ambassadors mature, they may welcome others, mentor newer believers, lead Bible studies, host house gatherings, participate in outreach, and help establish new communities wherever God opens doors. Growth is measured not merely by attendance, but by believers faithfully encouraging, discipling, and equipping others.
